

SOCIETY FOR LIGHT TREATMENT AND BIOLOGICAL RHYTHMS 2002 Call for Abstracts

The fourteenth annual meeting of the Society for Light Treatment and Biological Rhythms will be held in **San Diego, from June 13 through June 15, 2002**. As in past years, the meeting will begin with a poster session and reception on Thursday evening and will end with the CME course Saturday afternoon. The program is beginning to take shape – Tom Wehr will give the keynote address.

The deadline for receipt of abstracts is April 13. We will try to notify all those who submit abstracts by May 5.

Presentation Formats. Below are the traditional meeting formats. However, we do not want to discourage creativity, and if you have an idea that does not fit one of these formats, please contact me, Michael Young (youngm@iit.edu) to discuss it. Submitting an abstract is considered a commitment that the author will attend the meeting and present the work; this includes posters.

Symposia/panel discussions are proposed by a chairperson who is an SLTBR member. Participants may include non-members. These presentations are generally 1-1.5 hours, including discussion time. It is highly desirable that the symposium be an integrated presentation and not simply a collection of papers. How this is so should be included in the overview abstract (see formats below). All abstracts for the symposium/panel discussion should be submitted by the chairperson and at the same time.

Papers for presentation as posters and talks are submitted individually. Submissions accepted for oral presentation will be organized by the Program Committee into sessions that generally include 3-4 papers and discussion. Submissions accepted as posters will be displayed beginning Thursday evening and through Saturday morning. As usual, there will be a poster discussion (to be scheduled).

Special instructions for Panel Discussions/Symposia. The sponsoring chairperson should submit an **overview** abstract of **no more than 150 words** describing the content of the proposed session and how it is integrated into a symposium. In addition, each participant should prepare a **presentation** abstract as per the [Abstract Format information](#) describing the content of the presentation. The **chairperson** should submit **all** abstracts for a particular symposium or panel discussion.
